How to get to Brno

Vienna Schwechat International Airport (120 km from Brno, approx. 2 hours 20 min. journey)

1) **By (direct) bus.** The bus stop is conveniently located right outside the arrivals area. The journey takes around 2 hours and 20 minutes. Tickets can be purchased online, starting at 20 € one way:

2) **By train.** There are only a few direct [Regiojet](http://www.regiojet.cz) connections to Brno each day. Otherwise, you'll need to transfer at Wien Hauptbahnhof (Central Train Station). Tickets can be purchased online, starting from 22 € one way.

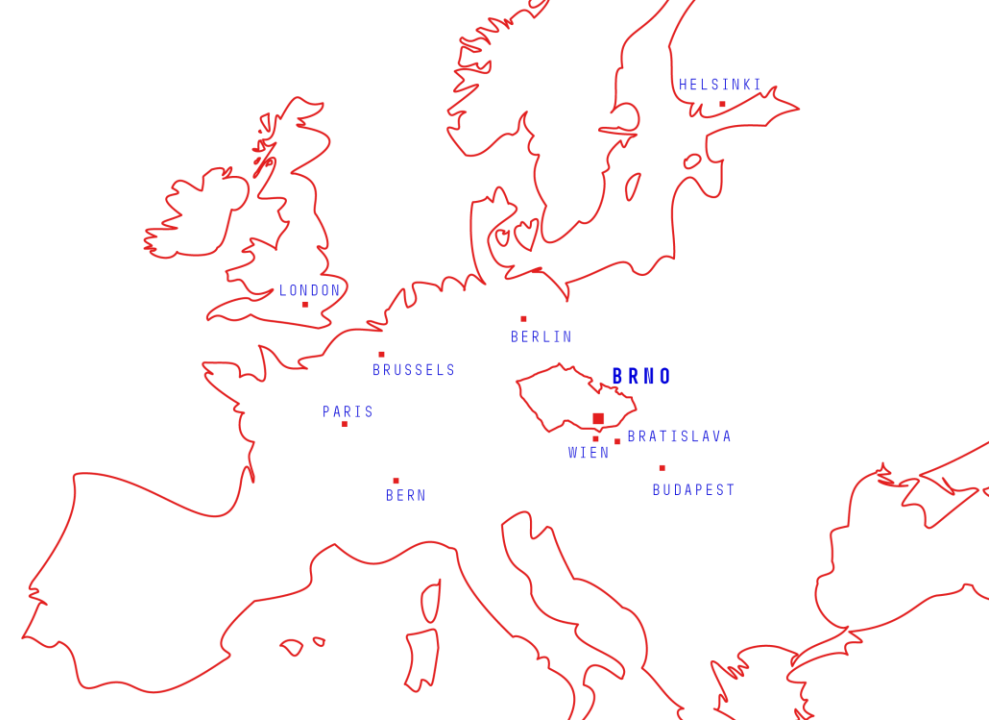
Brno - Tuřany Airport

(12 km from Brno, approx. 20 min. journey)

Provides flights to London/Stansted and other charter destinations. You can easily take a taxi or the express bus E76 (to Main Train Station), the stop is located directly outside the entrance to the airport terminal.

Václav Havel Airport Prague

(200 km from Brno, approx. 3 hours journey)

1) **By train.** The Airport Express buses, located in front of Terminals 1 and 2, will take you to the Prague Main Railway Station (outside the building, 40 min, 4 €). From there, the train to Brno takes approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes (one way journey from 16 €).

2) **By bus.** You can take a [Regiojet](http://www.regiojet.cz) bus, which stops directly in front of Terminal T1. At Prague's Florenc Bus Station, you will transfer to a connection heading to Brno (*The longest option – waiting for a connection to Brno 30–50 min*)

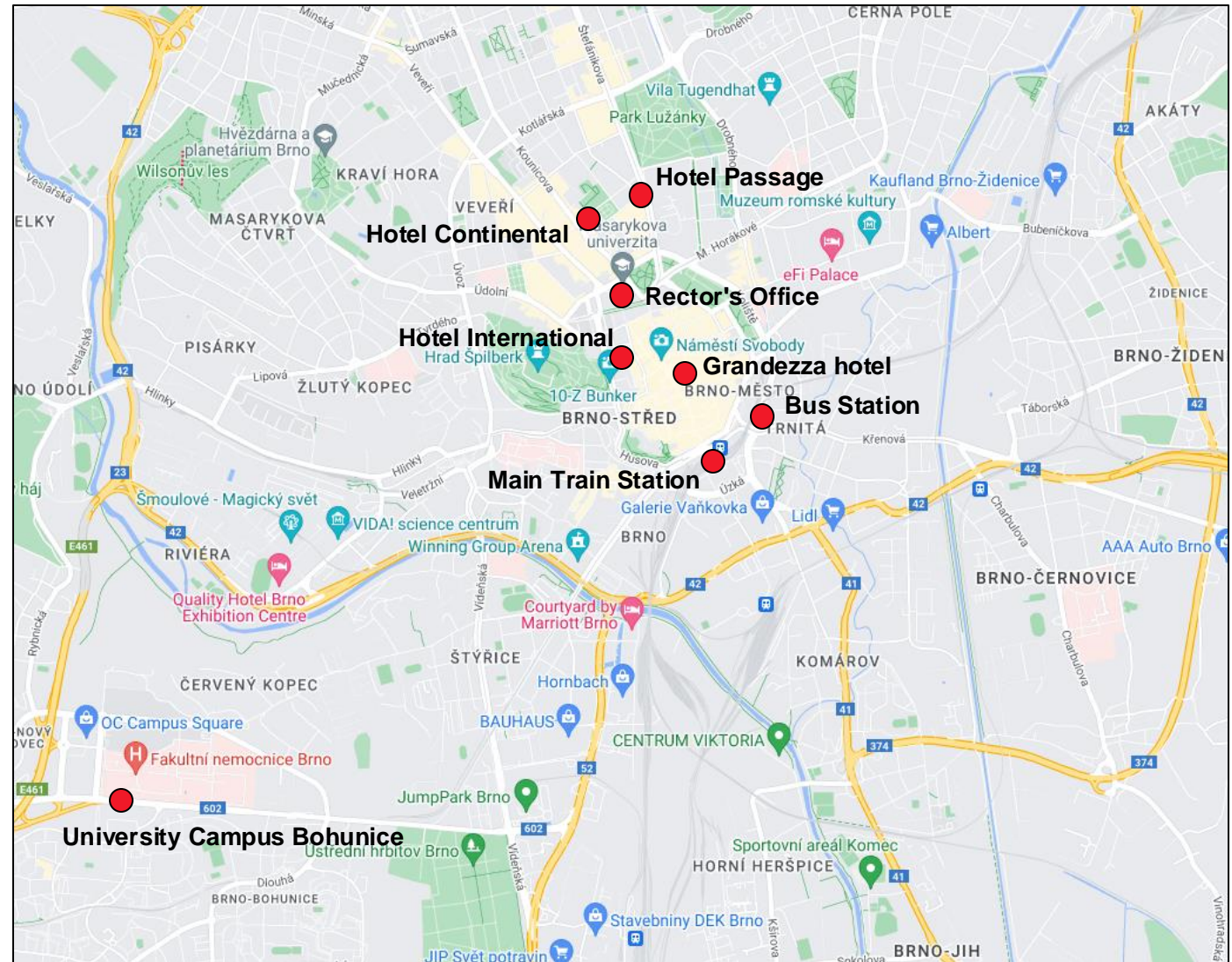
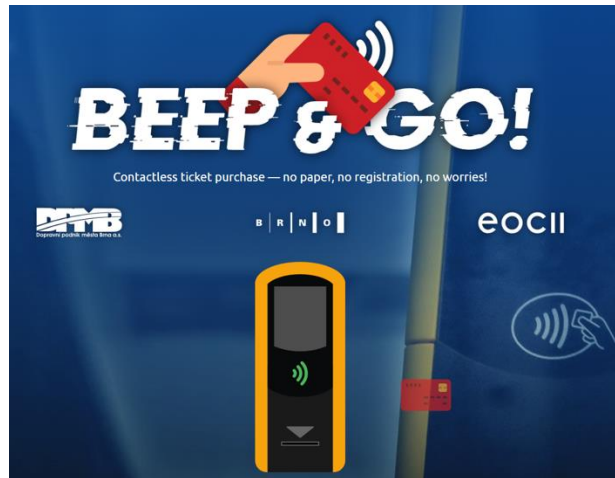

Transportation in Brno

Brno Public Transport Authority serves the whole city with public transport.

Brno uses [Beep and Go](#) system: public transport tickets can be conveniently purchased directly inside trams, buses, and trolleybuses using a credit card or a smartphone. Simply tap your card or phone on the onboard payment terminal, and your ticket will be issued automatically.



Places to see in Brno

As the second-largest city in Czech Republic, Brno is full of historical buildings and interesting places. Here's a list of a few of them that are worth visiting:

[The Cathedral of St Peter and Paul](#) – a gothic cathedral that today represents one of the city's most prominent landmarks

[Špilberk castle](#) – a castle and fortress forming a dominant feature of the city of Brno

[Villa Tugendhat](#) – an architecturally significant building, one of the prototypes of modern architecture in Europe

[Moravian Gallery in Brno](#) – the second largest art museum in the Czech Republic

[Vida Science centre](#) – science centre with more than one hundred and eighty interactive exhibits

[Ossuary at the Church of St James](#) – a place formerly used to inter the skeletal remains from graves with a mystical atmosphere

[Old Town Hall](#) – significant historical building with a lookout tower with amazing views of Brno

[Brno Observatory and Planetarium](#) – science centre near a beautiful city park where you can look into the microworld, discover the secrets of life and much more
