Thematic Clusters/RI data and tools federation and uptake Federated e-Infrastructure resources uptake

Access Do you believe that there should be a universal top-level point of access to the EOSC portal, pointing to/federating others (national, thematic)?
Do you think that RIs and e-Infras should have their own entry to EOSC services too?

Horizontal Has your RI federated services from horizontal projects, for example, are AAI **services** approaches adopted by RIs?

Or other services like PID, or FAIRness assessment tools?

Is there good coordination with horizontal projects to achieve these services?
How is the outlook for the future?

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Commercial Is your RI using/planning to use commercial services (e.g. cloud/storage) **services** or services from existing research providers?

If the latter, by other horizontal/thematic providers or procure your own?

EOSC Are there models for such work that could be adopted in the next phase?

Composability Are value-added services for RIs/communities such as data analysis and **of services** visualisation being co-worked (between horizontal and thematic providers)?

And/or are they planned for the future? (EOSC next phase).

The rules for EOSC Operators are focusing more on the federating core/horizontal providers. Do you believe that a section on thematic providers is also required?
