FAIR+R data and services,
OS policies

- Representants all working towards FAIR, some since a long time
- Most challenging is interoperability, reusability is hard to measure
- Everyone trying to find out incentives for users, e.g. journals asking for DOIs, chain of credits and attribution
- CC-BY 4.0 for data vs CC0 for metadata?
- Datasets not seen as research outcomes by funding agencies
- FAIR not considered a priority for funders in many of the countries
- FAIR difficult to measure , repository certifications and maturity models help there
- FAIR is different than open and at least metadata should be open
- Very different results for scientists awareness of FAIR, we have to show the benefits, the value for 'money'
- Not all data are equal - some data are more equal than other
