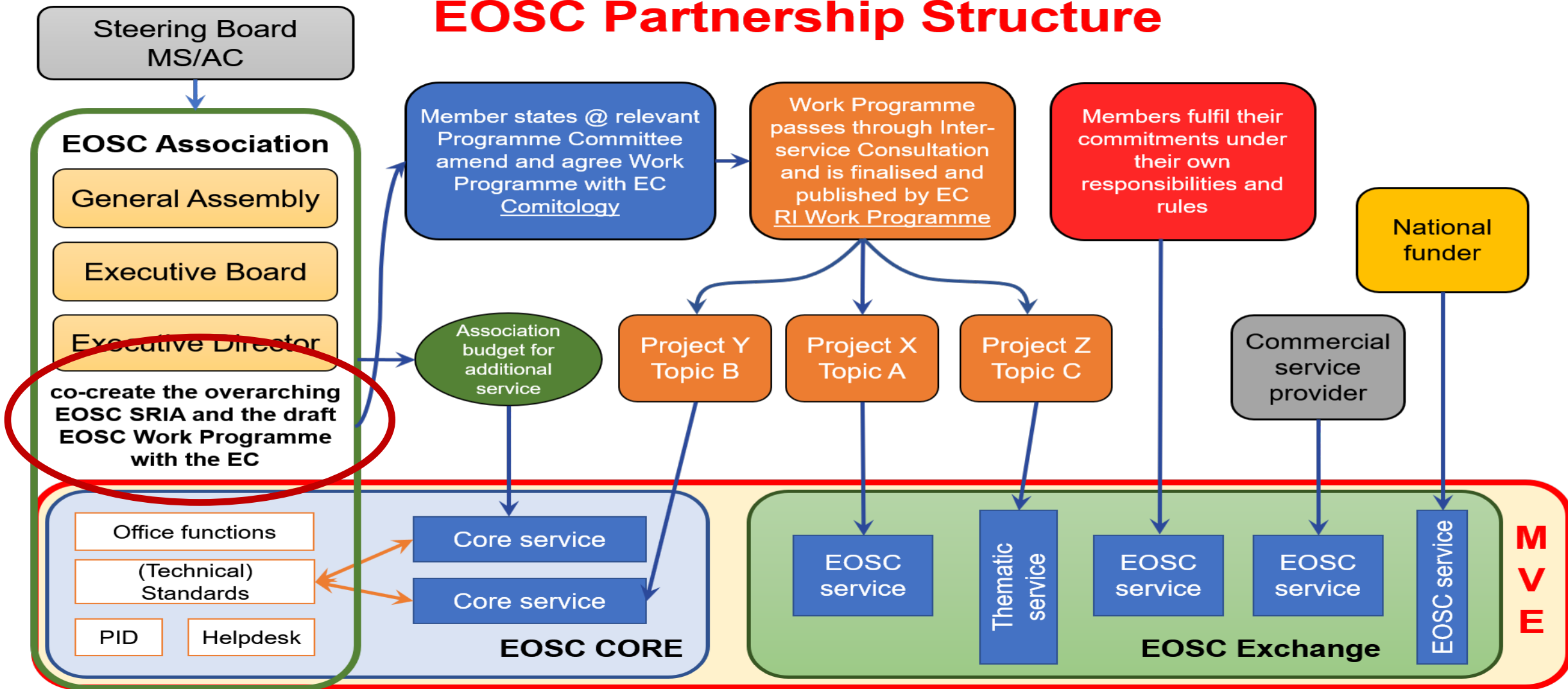

How are we developing the EOSC SRIA?

- Grounding information taken from Strategic Implementation Plan, EOSC Partnership Proposal
- Executive Board, together with European Commission and Governance Board have developed a high level outline
- EOSC Working Groups have submitted content on status, gaps and priority activities needed in each of 14 Action Areas
- Open Consultation leading to 217 responses

SRIA open consultation process

- EOSC SRIA Consultation held from 20 July to 31 August 2020
- Run by the EOSC Secretariat under leadership by the EOSC Executive Board (EB)
- Based on SRIA consultation document (input from the EOSC partnership proposal and early work by the EB on the SRIA)

- ❖ 3 Strategic Objectives
- ❖ 14 Action Areas
- ❖ 20 Priorities
- ❖ 10 High level KPIs

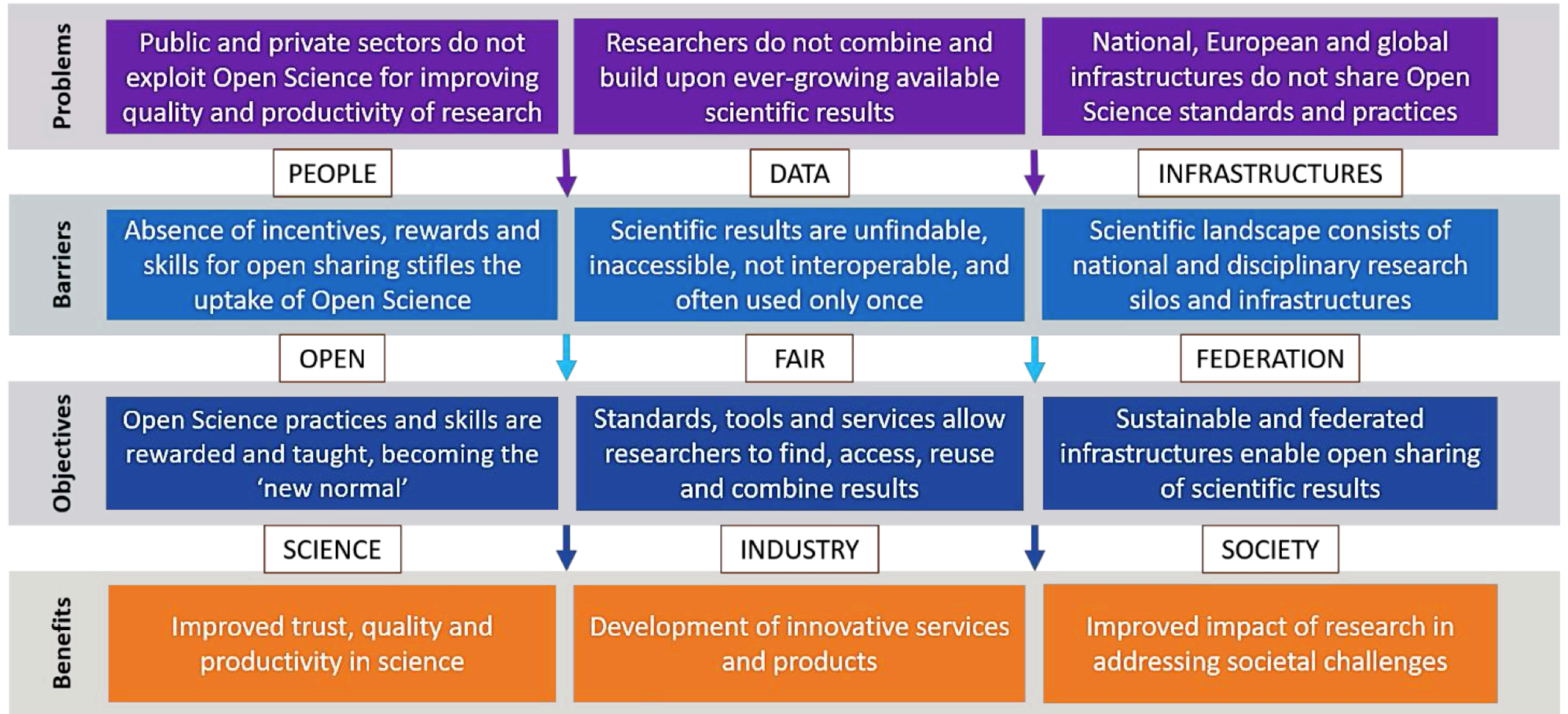
