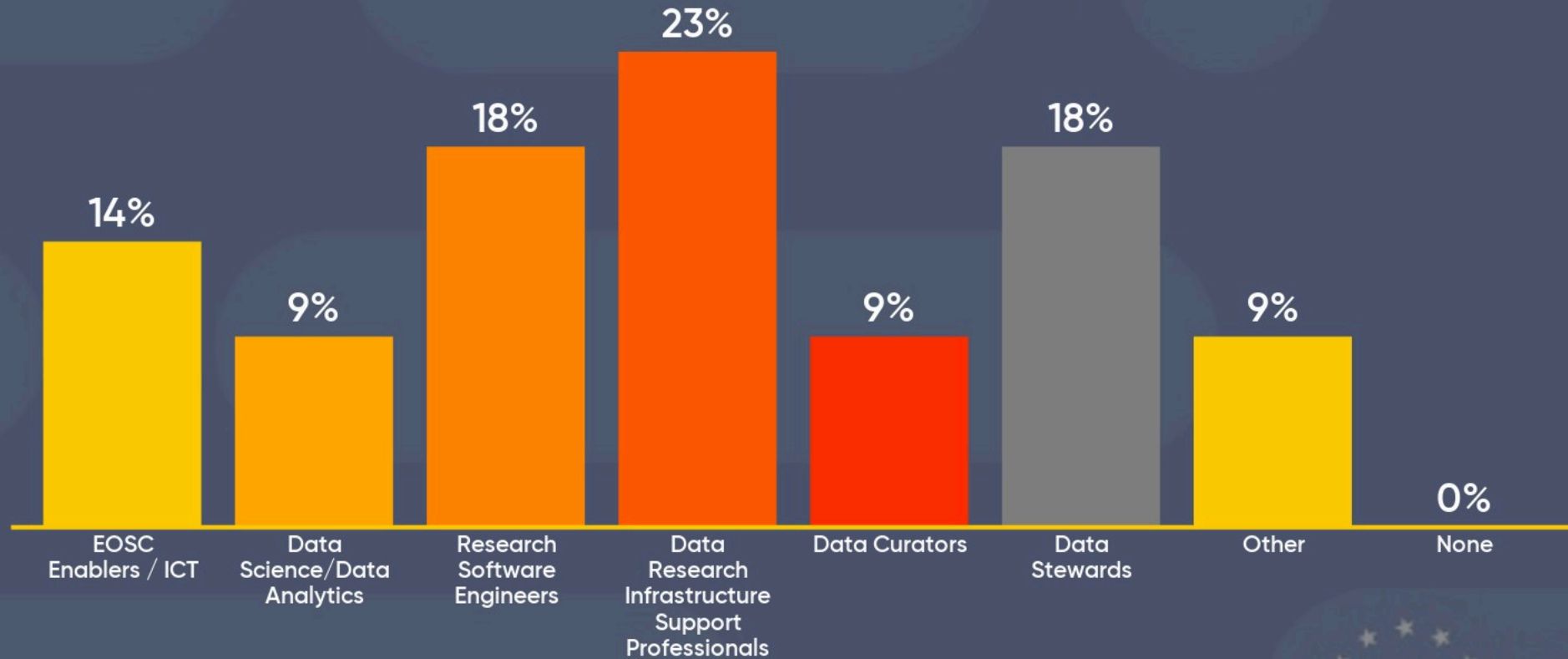
- **Skillsets** to add
 1. interdisciplinarity
 2. communication
- **Coordination**
 1. Among “neighboring” RIs with minimal set of common targets
 2. Link trainers
- **Training catalogues:** build consensus on quality assessment criteria and mechanisms
- **Sustainability of training** as part of the MVE

In ELIXIR, at the level of Research infrastructures work pretty well

Some general material that can be customized for specific community

Coordination would be needed at all levels. From EOSC to RIs a minimum set of common targets, like a minimum skill to be acquired, would be beneficial to structure our activities.

It could be more a meta-catalogue that use the Catris list of RIs to present the training catalogues that each RIs have in place



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How do you envision an EOSC training catalogue(s) and training services best fit RI/community needs?

searchable by different categories (topic, subject area focus, length, level...)

Catalogues are hard to maintain and may depend on a lean description to reach proximate audiences (researchers rather than RI specialists). In the SSHOC Marketplace we are looking at 'recipes' that bring together questions, data, tools and relevant.

Update catalogues

We would welcome semi-automatic interlink with existing RIs catalogues (former MERIL, current CatRIs, or www.wayforlight.eu for synchrotrons, free electron lasers and lasers).

To Link different resources, ex: personas, tools, infra,

searchable (topic, language, etc) , curated material, quality, sustainability

including evaluation (learning outcome successes) and trainer experiences
