# CERIC's Societal Return Report 2019

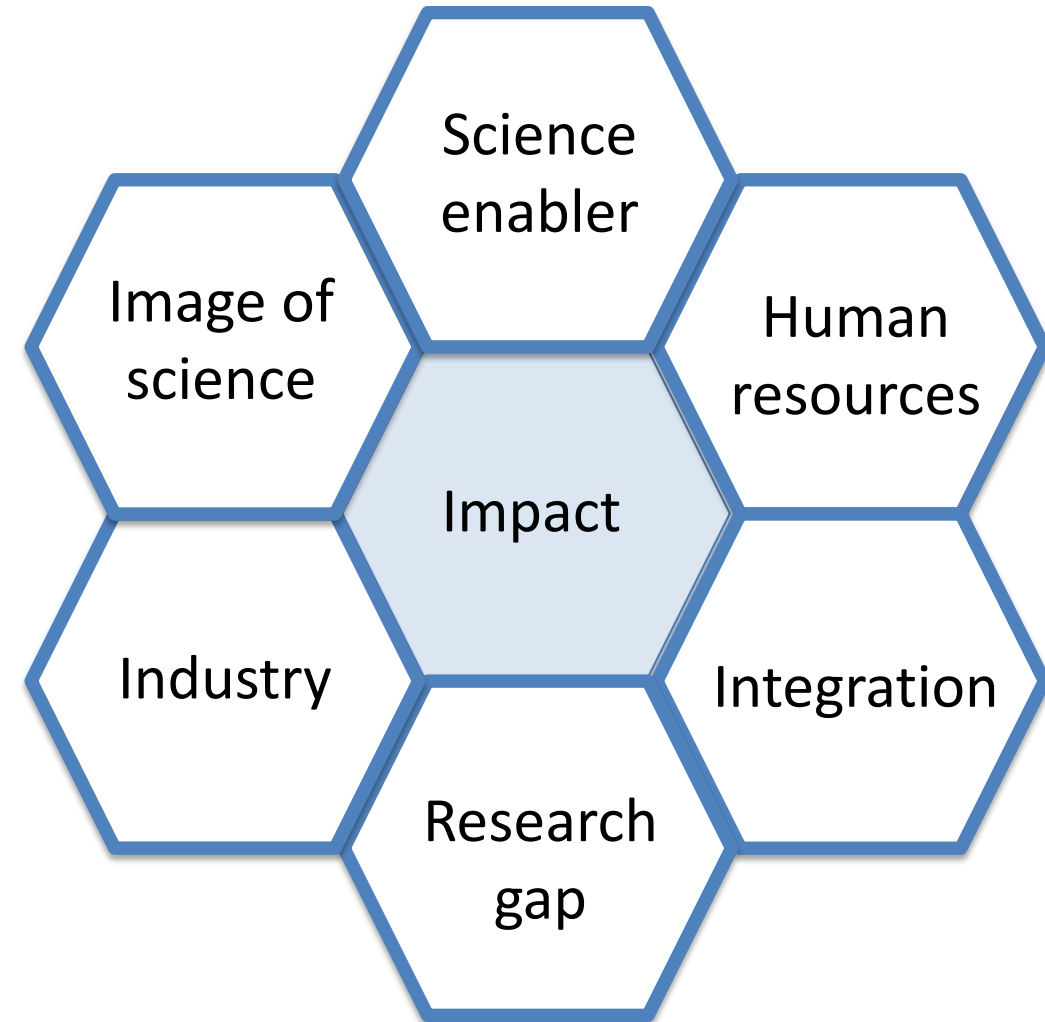


## Methodology:

## **Periodic evaluation of facilities** by external experts (example NMR):

- The high number and quality of publications by the users, mostly involving the PF's staff as co-authors. Per unit usage time, external users produce twice as many papers, as internal, demonstrating the benefits of the open access programme for the productivity of the NMR Centre.
- The participation in proposals to the Framework Programme through CERIC.

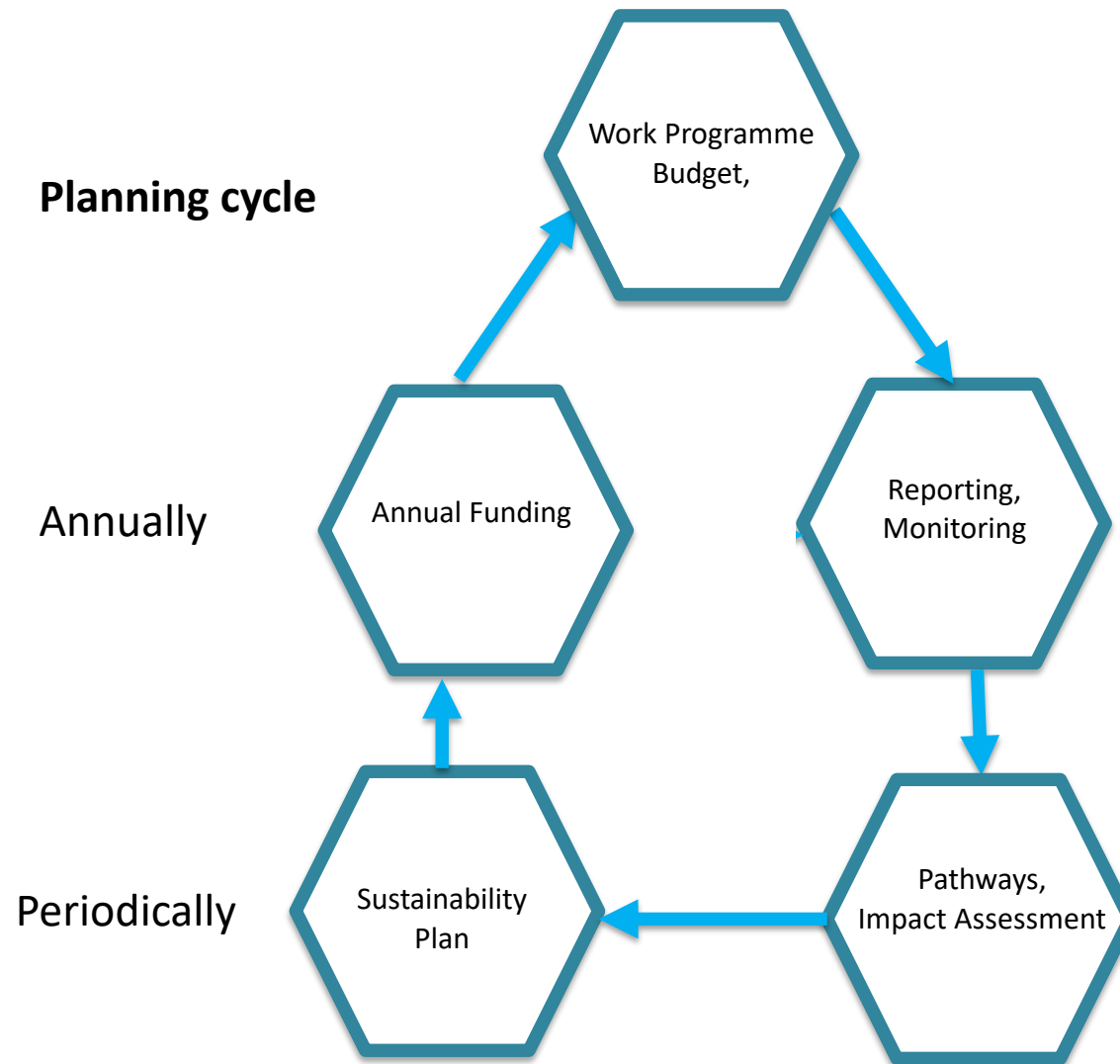
