Empower data producers/users/experts with relevant skills and capabilities

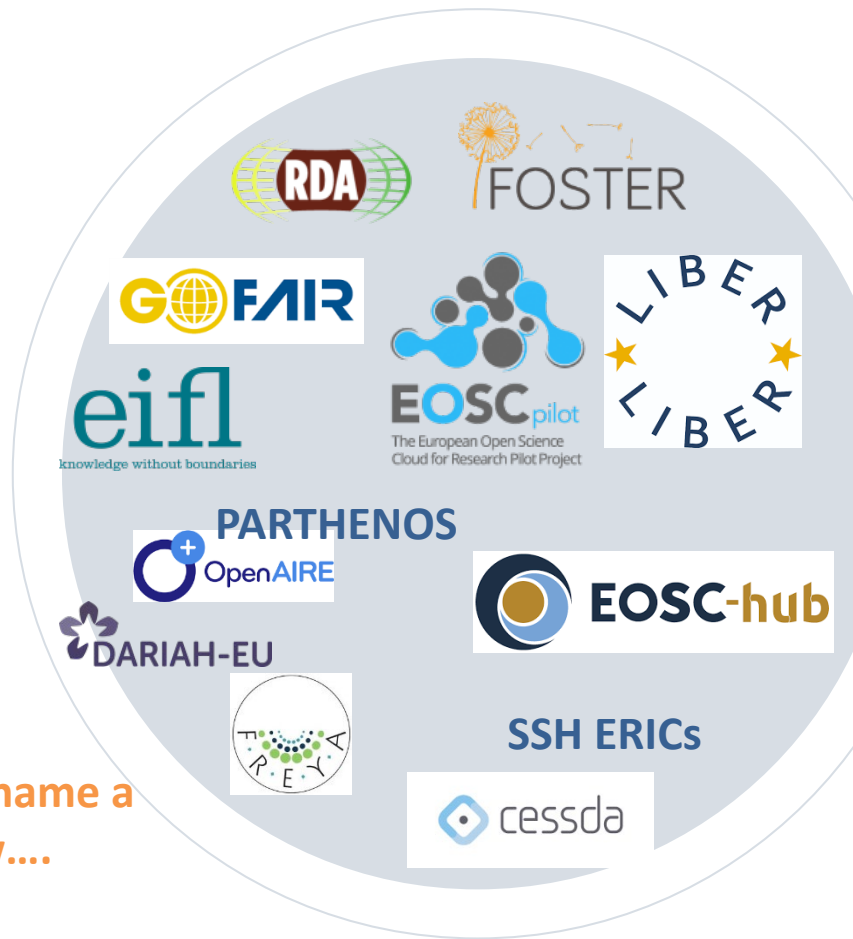


Networking and Collaboration
